Phone & Internet Issues As some of you may be aware, we have been having some phone and internet issues on campus. Please

see below for information directly from our tech support.

Thank you so much for your patience as we deal with these issues.

Recently, we had a series of service outages for phone, internet, and data. We believe it all started with an unexpected power issue, such as a power surge, that took down multiple devices on the network. As of now, the data and internet is up and running while work continues on the Home phone connections to make them stable. The phone vendor did a total rebuild of the NEC voice system and it is being monitored. We are working hard to get everything resolved as quickly as possible.

Additionally, we are looking at improving the connectivity between the buildings so that internet, data, and voice work flawlessly. For this we are looking at a couple options, and fiber optics is one of the mediums being explored. To start this initiative, we have contacted the Springfield Utility Board (SUB) to complete a feasibility study and system engineering to connect all buildings via fiber optics. We are looking forward to finding a viable solution and we will keep you informed along the way.
