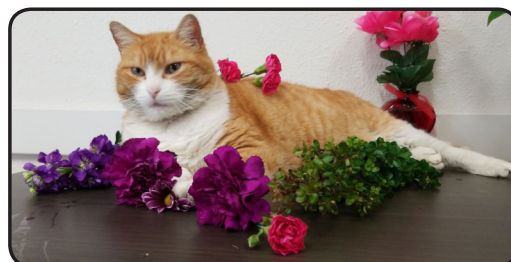
Hubert "Skip" Stevenson
