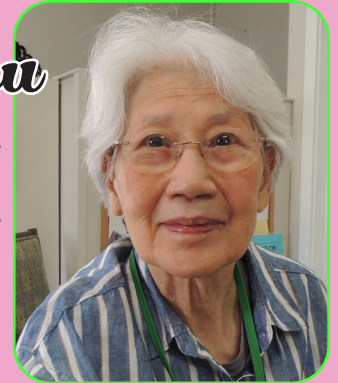
Dorothy "Jean" Armentrout
