We had a blast with this art project - Sensory Painting!

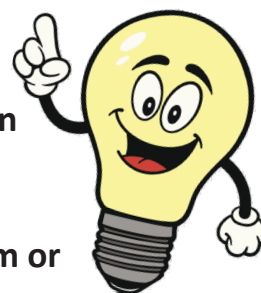
Residents created works of art with finger painting while using a ziplock bag. All the fun without the mess!

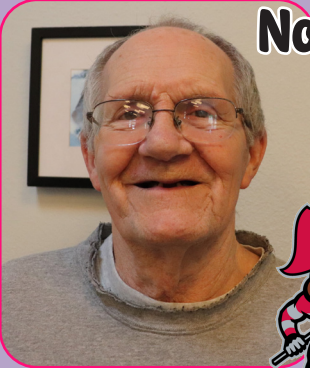

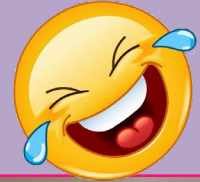
WELCOME to our Village!!

John is a social butterfly who enjoys spending time with others. He also loves men's club and has a great sense of humor.



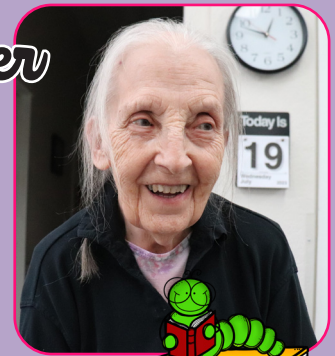
Ione Pinson

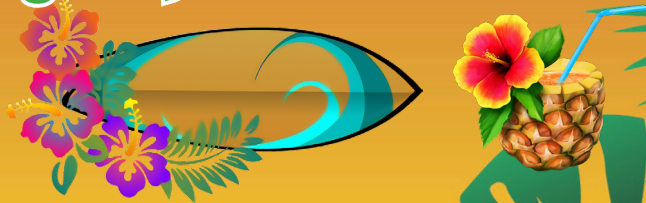

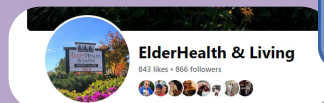

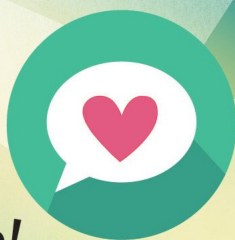


Chau Hoang

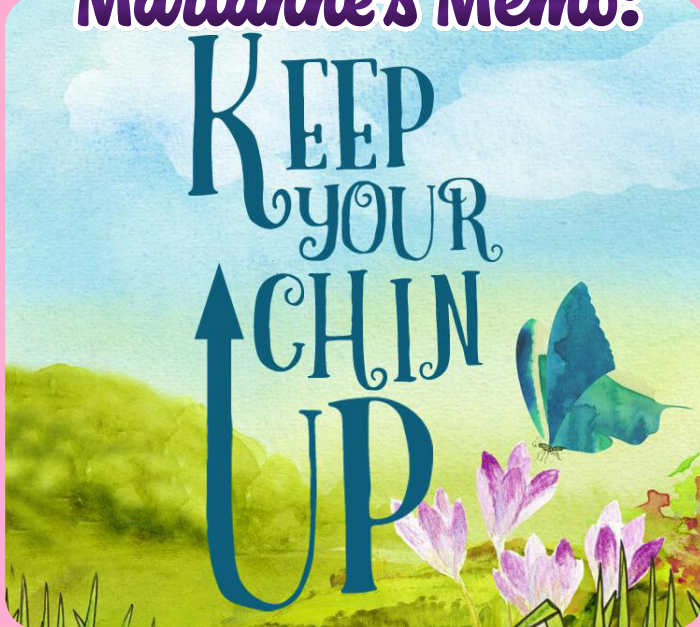
