November is a month for giving thanks. For this edition of our newsletter we asked our residents and employees what they were most thankful for.

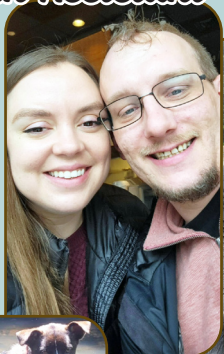

...for my best friend and amazing wife. She's given me the best ten years of my life.

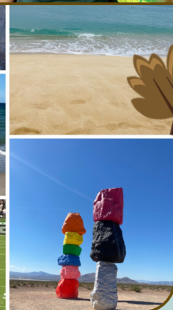

I love every minute I get to spend with my boyfriend, Aaron. I am an avid gamer and I am absolutely obsessed with true crime documentaries.

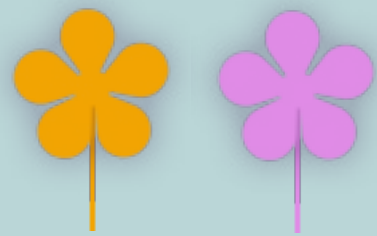

Residents enjoyed artwork delivered to us from the Thurston Elementary School students!




